

## Chung-Jen Junior College of Nursing, Health Sciences and Management 2022 Higher Education Sprout Project

The summary and highlights of the achievement of our school's higher education deep-cultivation plan in 2022 years are as follows in accordance with the four major aspects:

### 1. Implement teaching innovation and improve teaching quality:

1. Cooperating with the curriculum and various counseling mechanisms, the ratio of the number of students who completed off-campus internships to the total number of internship students has increased significantly. The pass rate of interns in 2022 was 99.2% (97.9% in 2021).

2. A total of 188 students will participate in 2022. As of September 2022, 228 graduates have participated in the Wings Program, and about 92% of the students are currently employed. This fully corresponds to the spirit of the Wings Program of the Ministry of Education. Graduation is employment, Fuying College to cultivate talents with immediate combat capabilities in the industry.

3. The results of participating in competitions and obtaining professional certificates in various subjects are outstanding. For example, alumnus Yishen Huang represented Taiwan in the 2022 International Skills Competition (Health Care Category) held in France and won the "Silver Medal".



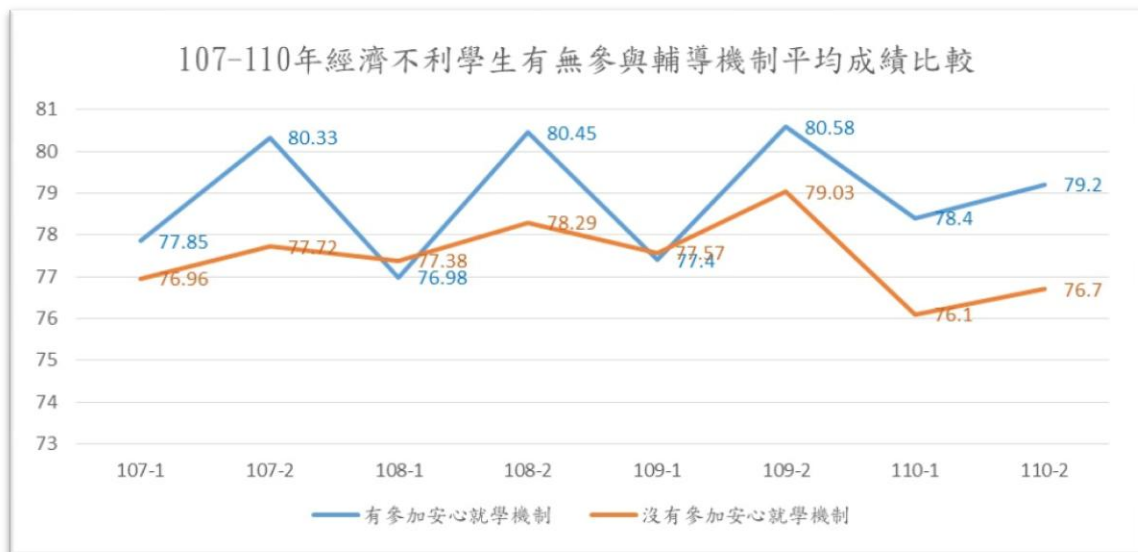
## 2. Develop school characteristics:

In terms of developing school characteristics, the school is rooted in the local area and cultivates practical and practical professionals. The school uses "expanding international horizons", "strengthening industry-university cooperation", and "cultivating core industry talents" as school-running characteristics to shape the school enterprise The new brand and the social responsibility of sustainable development are preferred. The school is actively developing its international capabilities, and through various international activities, it expands the international vision of the teachers and students of the school. Due to the impact of the new crown epidemic, internationalization activities have been adjusted in line with the epidemic situation, and foreign teachers' on-campus residency plans, real-time online real-time interactive English learning by foreign teachers, English training camps for basic nursing majors, and English training camps for science and technology have been implemented, and students have been sent to participate in the national English-related competitions, such as applied foreign language students participated in the 1st National High School Vocational and Technical College English Picture Book Creative Teaching Competition and won the third place, and nursing students participated in the 2022 Second Daai Cup Technical College Nursing Clinic The practical skills competition won the first place in the medical English terminology and medical record reading team competition, and won the fifth place and excellent work in the 2022 Chang Gung Cup National College Professional English Speaking Competition. Through the Higher Education Intensive Cultivation Program, students are provided with international exchange opportunities and language learning. At the same time, students are sent to participate in relevant competitions to quickly improve learning effectiveness and cultivate international communication skills.



### 3. Enhancing the publicity of higher education

The implementation of this effect enhances the publicity of higher education, and the highlight is that the assistance mechanism for economically disadvantaged students has achieved remarkable results. From 2018 to 2022, our school implemented a total of 23 measures, including safe schooling and life counseling, which benefited an average of 1,600 students each year. The school will conduct a rolling review of various financial assistance measures for studying with peace of mind. In addition to continuing to implement on the existing basis, the school plans to increase the scope of subsidies and expand the amount of subsidies. Summarizing the 2018-2022 year, analyzing relevant data, and comparing the average difference in academic performance between students who participated in the program and students who did not participate, it can be seen that the implementation of the program has achieved remarkable results, and it has indeed helped students' learning performance.



#### 4. Social responsibility

In 2022, the school will continue to deepen its higher education development plan, and use the complete software and hardware facilities of the "Holistic Education Resource Center" in the Dalin Campus to stimulate the energy of social responsibility on this basis. In 2022, the effectiveness of community cooperation has been improved, with the total number of cooperative communities reaching 20% (number of cooperative communities/total number of communities in Dalin Township), 42 elderly health promotion activities such as meals for the elderly were held, and more than 1,000 local elderly people were served.
